- (1) 是土壤部分,一种美国人的文化,在听力中多见。如,比赛一输要放弃了,第二人劝;课程太难坚持不住要 quit 了,第二人劝;小说人物复杂不想读了,第二人劝;减肥坚持不住,第二人劝等等。
- (2) 弘扬 brightsides, 听力中的美国学生永远是学习,有任何事情与之冲突都要放弃其它而学习;这么多年考试中,偶有一次例外,当然发生在男生身上,一女生邀他玩,他来了一句: "Thebookcanwait" 丢人的话来。除此之外,别无



例外。比如:在第一人话中出现娱乐项目,而第二人 话中出现学习类项目,可想而知下文是什么了。

- (3) 又是一个美国文化,区别与我们的文化对待。ThinkinginAmericanway (4) 见人有衣无衣都 great;有头发无头发都 great;体形好不好都 great,所以 理解后用于生活中,有美国人 说: "YourEnglishisgood."千万别自喜,因为 他们的文化就是这个。
- (5) firstthingfirst,用于抓态度,绕难点解题。应用于我们的写作中, 先给 point 再 develop。

托福考试要得高分关键还是得看听力

摘要: <u>托福</u>考试要得高分关键还是得看听力, <u>托福考试</u>中, 听说读写四部分有三部分都要用到听力, 所以<u>托福听力</u>是托福高分的关键。大家在准备托福考试的时候要把最大的力气放在托福听力上面。

因为听说读写这四部分考试内容里,有三部分实际上都在考听力,所以就可以看出来托福考试更注重交流,把听说读写融合在一起考查考生的英语综合能力。

首先,听力部分难度逐年加大,由过去的小对话全部改成长对话和长段子, 内容也增加了校园情景和课堂讨论,所以要求考生听力水平要特别强。

第二,口语中有6道题,1、2题就问考生一些简单话题,例如"描述一下你所居住的城市是什么样子的"。口语后面4道题全是和听力有关的,根据听到的问题进行回答,可见听力的比重占得特别大。

第三,写作中有一部分叫"综合写作",先读一篇,再听一篇,然后根据读到和听到的内容进行总结写作,真正把阅读、听力、写作结合在一起考查,使得考试变得更加科学了。在最后复习过程中,如果考生听力弱,一定要以模考题为导向,熟悉环境,加强听力训练,在短期内也会有一定的提高。

想要拿下托福听力,大量的听是必要的内容,另外大家还要对《<u>新托福</u>考试官方指南》里听力考试内容和题型的相关部分读透,把书中的题读透。这样才能争取拿到高分。

怎样提高托<mark>福听力水平</mark>ITED STATES

摘要:很多人<u>托福</u>考试拿不了高分,就是因为<u>托福听力</u>分数低。怎样提高托福听力水平一直是很多考生关心的问题在于。针对新<u>托福考试</u>听力部分,考生应该系统提高听力能力并且熟悉<u>新托福</u>听力部分的题型和思路,通过一段时间的强化练习应该可以取得满意的成绩。

怎样提高托福听力水平?托福听力技巧总结:

1. 熟悉题型及出题方式,总结听力中常见的场景。把托福的听力场景分类。

2. 练习做笔记的能力

练习速记关键词、关键句。新托福听力部分的新颖之处在于允许考生在听材料的过程中记录重要的信息点。根据这一条最新要求,考生就要在平时的准备中做适当的练习,提高记录的效率,能够在一定的时间内速记下重要的信息点,包括名词、动词和其他重要的表达法。

3. 练习听力中抗干扰的能力

在新托福的听力测试中,有许多文章材料有较多的插入语和连接词,这样就给考生抓关键词、关键句的方面带来很大障碍。有许多章节信息量过于集中,不易于考生在有效时间内完成题目。因此,考生在听力的过程中,应该集中精力抓住文章的主要脉络,对于其他的细节或偏题的段落应该大胆略过,确保自己的思路是按照文章的主要内容而发展,这样在回答考生最畏惧的主旨题时才能不被字面的意思所干扰。

4. 强化托福听力词汇

在平时的学习积累中,考生要不断增加自己的词汇量,针对新托福听力部分的出题形式,考生要以掌握单词的标准读音作为主要目的,通过反复的练习达到强化的目的。新托福听力的语速与现行托福听力的语速相似,无较大变化,而且发音非常清晰标准,所以考生在平时的复习中,要练习并纠正自己的语音语调,尽量模仿标准的语音,这样既可以达到练习听力的目的,又可以达到提高口语的目的。

怎样提高托福听力水平?相信大家看了上面的托福听力技巧总结,心理也应该有数了。希望以上的内容能帮助大家。

怎样练习托福听力

摘要:怎样练习托福听力?我们首先推荐就是进行概括,概括就是在听过听力材料后,备考的同学可以对文章大意进行总结和概括。考生不需要听懂托福材料的每一个细节,但要抓住说话人的思路和框架。这个训练对于托福听力至关重要。练习概括的方法也很简单,可以用托福听力中的lecture为材料,一边听一边记笔记,录音结束后,根据大脑记忆和笔记,对全文重点内容用英文进行复述,这样反复练习,直到可以将一篇lecture文章完全复述出来为止。



托福听力,大家比较常见的一种练习方法就是听写,这是大家比较熟悉的练习方法,也是相对来说对所有考生都行之有效的一种方法。它就是将一篇托福听力录音中的原文全部听录下来,一句一句丝毫不落,它是提高听力最有效的方法。对于准备托福考试的考生而言,最好的听写材料是老托福的lecture。推荐part 3 的 93 篇文章,对于基础不同的同学,可以选择其他的适合自己水平的材料进行练习,再用老托福听力,同时辅助一些长篇的段落听写练习。

练习听力,对于任何一种英语考试来说,都少不了精听这一环节。到底该怎么精听呢?其步骤如下:一边听一边看听力材料原文,划出自己不认识或似曾相识但反应不过来的词;录音结束,开始查生词,写在原文的旁边,只要写出这个单词在这篇文章中的意思即可;然后将这篇材料当阅读文章快速精读一遍,彻底看懂;再一边看原文,一边放录音,嘴上要跟读,反复几遍,一直听到可以不看原文彻底听懂为止。如大家比较常用的SSS(Scientific American's Sixty-second Science),非常短,但信息量很大,是很好的练习材料。

用相对老说高于自己能力的材料进行挑战练习。备考托福听力挑战性的材料有这几类:一是美国大学上课的课堂录像或录音,现在很多美国大学已经将许多公开课的课堂录像放在了互联网上,这是一个极佳的挑战听力难度的材料。二是巴朗和Kaplan上的试题可以选用或者用DELTA上的试题通过变速软件加2倍速来做,这样就会超越考试难度。虽然过程痛苦,而且容易打击信心,但是用更难的材料练习,再去听容易的就会比较容易听出来,心理上也有很大的自信心。

要培养时时在考试的感觉,时时听英语的感觉。也就是要为自己创造一个英文的环境,比如早晨一起床,我们就打开音箱播放英语,可以是托福的听力材料,可以是英文广播,也可以是一部英文电影等,这样做的好处是随时都可以听到英语,在潜移默化中不知不觉地加深对英语的敏感度,培养语感。这是一个比较长期的任务,对于备考时间较长的同学,是和可以选用的方法。

乍听上去,强调原则显得很笼统。其实具体可分为两大类:语义强调和语气、语 调强调。

语义强调包括含义强调、解释强调、举例强调、级别强调、结论强调、对比强调 等六种。

语气、语调强调包括重音强调、停顿强调、清晰强调等三种。

托福听力: 秘诀在于VOA边听边说

中 广网北京 8 月 2 日消息 就在前天我刚刚写完答学生问,帮助大家总结听力复习计划几分钟后,校内有个黎同学就开始围观我了,说哈哈老师,我听力考了满分哦!老师我当场吐血,说实话 我最近也没有考到满分。接着黎同学应老师邀请迅速写了篇考后感,写得非常非常详细,异常认真,因为小黎是工科学生,相信他的考后感会对很多同学都有用和启发。

我先后考过两次托福,第一次 102 分,第二次 108 分,在第二<mark>次</mark>考试里听力居然满分,挺惊喜的。

我真正开始投入大量时间准备托福大概有3个月。由于还在上课,每天准备托福的时间也就是4小时左右。但平时去教室的路上、坐公交、吃饭时也经常是戴着耳机听VOA、《科学美国人》还有《托福高分作文》配套音频。这种零碎时间加起来平均每天也应该有一个小时,闲暇时间也经常是关了字幕看英文电影。

一般情况下,尤其是对于像我这种工科生,大学里在准备GT之前是很少会花大量心血准备的。记得有同学开玩笑说过,如果是高三暑假去考托福就好了。的确,没有 GT的话,大学生的英语水平通常是逐年降低的。想让逐渐降低的英语水平反弹,肯定是需要一番决心的。

做事都要遵循一个循序渐进的原则,听力的提高也不例外。如果一个英语基础一般的大学生直接用VOA来练听力,那多半是坚持不下来的一过高的强度会导致大脑的"罢工",非常容易走神。我开始练习听力时是用老托福的听力材料,就那种1分多钟1篇的。这套音频的语速、内容都不算太难理解,而且有对应的文章可以看,听的时候发现自己哪里跟不上了可以马上停下来看文章。如果想同时练习写作的同学可以换成《托福高分作文》配套音频听。

等到老<u>托福听力</u>材料已经能听懂80%,就可以提高难度了。作为面向外国人的英语能力测试,老托福的语速、连读情况和真正美国人说话自然还是有差别。而在老托福的听力材料之后,我就直接强迫自己听VOAstandard。这个跨度很大,



主要是因为我没能找到难度居于两者之间的听力材料。VOA的语速已经比新<u>托福考试</u>要快了,但其价值也正是如此。所谓"求其上上得其上",如果把VOA都能听懂,还怕托福听力吗?但果不其然,初听VOA时我大脑出现了严重的"罢工"现象,常常没听几分钟就走神了。为了让自己集中注意力,我开始"听说"。下面要重点说一下"听说"。

此"听说"非彼"听说"。上过新东方的同学基本都听说过"听写",这个方法拥有一大批拥护者。但我在尝试了几次后最终没有采用,一是因为很耗时间,二是因为过程很枯燥。如果有比较有决心的同学不妨一试。而我采用的方法是"听说"一耳朵听到的英语嘴巴跟着说,哪怕没听懂也尽量模仿那种发音。因为有了大脑的这个反馈过程,这样做能让自己专注于所听的材料,走神现象有了很大的改善。而与"听写"相比,这种方法花的时间较少,而且由于可以很快地听新内容而不是纠结于某个句子而一再重听,相比之下也没有那么枯燥。

不过我必须承认一点:直到考完托福,我听VOA也是很吃力的。我当时是下载十篇几分钟一段的VOAstandard,放到MP3里面反复听。第一遍往往只是听个大概,夸张一点说,就是抱着"寻宝"的态度去听一听着听着发现,"哟,这一句我能听懂唉!"然而反复听,第二遍,第三遍,第十遍.....今天听完明天继续,直到某天发现,这几篇报道的大意自己都明白了,就可以换一批新的了。注意,此时的"听明白"是个幻觉:我们只是能听明白这几篇文章,并不是说已经有听VOAstandard的听力水平了。换十篇新的VOA,第一遍依然听得很崩溃。然后再是第二遍,第三遍.....然后再换。

其实听力水平能听VOA后,已经足以应对托福考试了。但作为一个工科生,我对VOA的兴趣没有《科学美国人》大,于是又去下了许多《科学美国人》来 听。《科学美国人》的语速更快,更有挑战性,而且有一个bonus:由于《科学美国人》的话题都是科学类的,对于理解托福中科学题材的文章、听力,甚至口 语里的学科讲座部分也是有帮助的。

以上便<mark>是</mark>我复习听力的大致方法,肯定有不足之处,在此抛<mark>砖引</mark>玉,也希望能有同学能够提出更好、更系统化的复习意见!
